

# **What is Bible Prophecy?**

The fulfillment of Bible prophecy is indisputable proof that the men who wrote the Holy Scriptures were inspired by God (2 Pet. 1:19-21)! The significance and importance and relevance of Bible prophecy is such that the testimony of the Lord Jesus Christ Himself is based upon it (Rev. 19:10b).

Bible Prophecy is given to edify and to encourage and to comfort (1 Cor. 14:3) all who are trusting solely in the finished work of Christ, by faith alone, for their salvation. Bible Prophecy is specifically given for believers (1 Cor. 14:22b). The study of Bible Prophecy should lead to a deeper spiritual life as it did for Daniel (Dan. 9:1-19).

Those people, who in the past, chose to ignore and reject the prophecies of the Bible that were about them and their generation, were never able to avoid the consequences for doing so.
